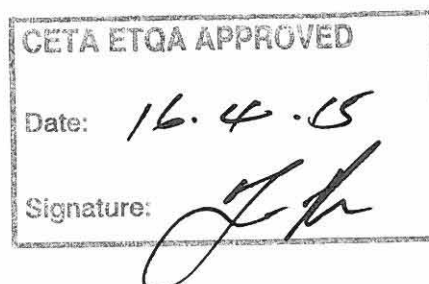

In respect to your Accreditation your attention is drawn to the following ETQA provisions:
